THE STATE OF ALASKA UNDER AS 46.15, THE ALASKA WATER USE ACT,
AND THE REGULATIONS ADOPTED UNDER IT, GRANTS TO:

ANCHORAGE, MUN (AWWU)

ANCHORAGE, AK. 99503

THE RIGHT TO DEVELOP THE USE OF WATER FROM THE FOLLOWING SOURCE:

A) EKLUTNA RESERVOIR WITH A PRIORITY DATE OF 01/16/1985

* 41.0 MILLION GAL/DAY
FOR PUBLIC SUPPLY JAN 01 THRU DEC 31

THE LOCATION TO WHICH THIS WATER RIGHT APPERTAINS IS:

THE WATER WILL BE USED WITHIN THE MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE
PUBLIC WATER DISTRIBUTION SYSTEM.

THE LOCATION OF THE WATER SOURCE IS THE EKLUTNA RESERVOIR AT THE
EXISTING WATER DIVERSION TUNNEL OWNED AND OPERATED BY THE ALASKA
POWER ADMINISTRATION, A UNIT OF THE DEPARTMENT OF ENERGY, LOCATED
WITHIN THE NE1/4NE1/4 PROTRACTED SECTION 8, TOWNSHIP 15 NORTH,
RANGE 2 EAST, SEWARD MERIDIAN.

* THE 41.0 MILLION GALLONS PER DAY IS THE AVERAGE DAILY USE BASED
UPON EXPECTED YEARLY DEMAND.

CHANGES IN THE NATURAL STATE OF WATER ARE TO BE MADE IN THE MANNER AND
ONLY FOR THE PURPOSES STATED IN THIS PERMIT. THIS PERMIT IS SUBJECT
TO THE PERTINENT STATUTORY PROVISIONS IN AS 46.15, ADMINISTRATIVE
REGULATIONS IN 11 AAC 93, AND THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS:

THE HOLDER OF THIS PERMIT SHALL:

DEFEND AND INDEMNIFY THE STATE AGAINST AND HOLD IT HARMLESS FROM
ANY AND ALL CLAIMS, DEMANDS, LEGAL ACTIONS, LOSS, LIABILITY AND
EXPENSE FOR INJURY TO OR DEATH OF PERSONS AND DAMAGES TO OR LOSS
OF PROPERTY ARISING OUT OF OR CONNECTED WITH THE EXERCISE OF THE
PRIVILEGE GRANTED BY THIS PERMIT.

COMPLY WITH ALL APPLICABLE LAWS, REGULATIONS AND CONDITIONS.

NOTIFY THE DIVISION OF LAND AND WATER MANAGEMENT, DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES OF ANY CHANGE OF ADDRESS OF THE GRANTEE OR TRANSFER OF ANY REAL PROPERTY IDENTIFIED IN THIS DOCUMENT.

ESTABLISH A METERING SYSTEM ACCEPTABLE TO THE DIVISION AND SUBMIT DAILY WATER USE RECORDS TO THE DIVISION ON A MONTHLY BASIS.

THE MAXIMUM DAILY DIVERSION OF WATER SHALL NOT EXCEED 72 MILLION GALLONS ON ANY SINGLE DAY.

THE QUANTITY OF WATER ASSOCIATED WITH THIS PERMIT WILL BE RE-EVALUATED AFTER 9, 15, 20, 25, 30 & 35 YEARS FROM THE DATE OF ISSUANCE.

THE ISSUANCE OF THIS PERMIT IS SUBJECT TO THE COMPENSATION AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE AND THE ALASKA POWER ADMINISTRATION DATED FEBRUARY 17, 1984 AND FURTHER SUPPORTED BY SECTION 4 OF PUBLIC LAW 98-552, 98 STAT. 2824 (1984).

THIS PERMIT SHALL EXPIRE ON 12/31/2025

THIS PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE WATER IS ISSUED BY AUTHORITY OF AS 46.15.080 AND 11 AAC 93.120 ON 16 December, 1985.
