To whom it may concern:

Since the Eklutna Hydroelectric Project became operational in 1955, it has caused the Eklutna River to run dry. The amount of power being produced by the hydro-dam is not sufficient to warrant leaving the Eklutna River disconnected from Eklutna Lake. The salmon migration has been blocked for long enough. The Native Village of Eklutna's alternative plan to remove the dam would allow for the recovery of Chinook, sockeye, and coho salmon, by re-connecting the river to the lake.
